



LOOK OUT FOR: SCAMS AGAINST SENIORS

LOOK OUT FOR THESE COMMON SCAMS USED AGAINST SENIOR CITIZENS:

- **EMERGENCY SCAM:** Fraudsters target grandparents by posing as a grandchild in trouble and in need of money
- **CANADA REVENUE AGENCY SCAM:** Seniors will be contacted by a tax agent requesting that they pay overdue taxes or face a penalty
- **LOTTERY SCAM:** Victims are told they've won a lottery or sweepstakes and that they should divulge personal banking information
